Wireshark packet capture and analysis, Kali Linux installation and configuration, VirtualBox/VMware lab setup, basic Linux command line proficiency.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q Do I need IT experience to start the Pen Tester Track?

No prior IT or cybersecurity experience is required. The track begins with Module 1 — IT & Networking Foundations — which starts from absolute zero. You'll learn networking concepts, Linux basics and set up your own security lab before moving into security and ethical hacking. If you already have an IT background, you may be able to skip Module 1 after a short placement assessment.

Q Which certifications does the Pen Tester Track prepare me for?

The Pen Tester Track prepares you for four industry-recognised certifications: ISC² CC (Certified in Cybersecurity), CompTIA Network+, CompTIA Security+ (SY0-701) and EC-Council CEH v13 (Certified Ethical Hacker). Each module's curriculum is directly aligned to the relevant exam objectives.

Q How long does the Pen Tester Track take?

The Pen Tester Track is 260 hours of training across three modules. Studied full-time, this takes approximately 3 months (13 weeks). A part-time option is available and roughly doubles the duration to about 6 months. All sessions are recorded so you can catch up if you miss a class.

Q Are certification exam fees included?

Certification exam fees are not included in the track fee of R28,000. Your tuition covers all training materials, lab environments and mock exams to prepare you fully before you sit the official exam. Exam vouchers can be purchased separately or are included as part of the Elite tier if you choose to enrol in the full bootcamp.

Q What equipment do I need?

Minimum: Any laptop or desktop with a web browser and stable, fast internet (10+ Mbps recommended). No specific hardware required—all labs run in your browser (Kali, DVWA, Juice Shop, cloud platforms). Specifications: 4 GB RAM minimum (8 GB recommended), 256 GB storage minimum. Highly recommended: External monitor for productivity. Ethernet connection preferred for reliability.

Q What does a penetration tester earn in South Africa?

Entry-level penetration testers and junior red team analysts in South Africa typically earn between R300,000 and R600,000 per year. Mid-level pen testers with CEH and 2–4 years of experience earn R700,000 to R1.2 million. Senior penetration testers, security consultants and red team leads earn R1.2 million to R2 million or more, with contract and consulting rates often exceeding salaried positions.
